TGT (SOCIAL SCIENCE)

Mandatory Qualifications

- A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as: **any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science**, of which one must be **History or Geography**.
- A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2026
- Ability to read/write/ communicate fluently in English

Desirable

- Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.
- Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

TGT (SCIENCE)

Mandatory Qualifications

- A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects. **Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, and Zoology (any three subjects should have been studied)**
- A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2026.
- Ability to read/ write/ communicate fluently in English.

Desirable

- Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.
- Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

TGT (SANSKRIT)

Mandatory Qualification

- A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with minimum marks of 50 percent in Sanskrit and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages.
- **Sanskrit as an elective subject at Degree Level**
- A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognized by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2026.
- Ability to read/ write/ communicate fluently in English

Desirable

- Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.
- Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

Mandatory Qualification

- A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum mark of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate,
- Diploma in Counselling from a recognised University or BA/ BSc Psychology with Educational Psychology/ Counselling Psychology from a recognised University or MA/ MSc in Counselling Psychology or MA MSc Psychology with Counselling Psychology as specialization or MA/MSc in Applied Psychology with Counselling Psychology from a recognized University.

- Senior Secondary (10+2) with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training or Diploma in Elementary Education from a Govt recognized institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference were to be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.
- Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2026.

Desirable

- Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection
- Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- Experience in art & craft, cartoon caricature, puppet making, music, dance etc.

LAB ATTENDANT

Mandatory Qualification

- 10+2 with Science from a Government recognized institute.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2026.
- Experience in handling of Science Labs

CLERK

Mandatory Qualification

- Graduate from a Govt recognised University.
- Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.
- Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July 2026.
- Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.
- Should be proficient in knowledge of computer applications, especially MS office.

Notes

1. Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
2. Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the school as per rules of the Society.

BASKETBALL INSTRUCTOR

- Applicants should have a degree/ diploma in Physical Education from NIS and be a Distinguished player of Basketball at State or National Level.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 35 years as on 01 July 2026.

VOLLEYBALL INSTRUCTOR

- A degree/ diploma in Physical Education from NIS and Distinguished player of Volley at State or National Level.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 35 years as on 01 July 2026.

DANCE INSTRUCTOR

- A degree/ diploma in classical dance and knowledge of various dance forms
- Should be in the age group of 21 and 40 years as on 01 July 2026.

FITNESS INSTRUCTOR

- A bachelor's degree from a recognized university.
- Should be able to handle gym equipment.
- Should be in the age group of 21 to 35 years as on 01 July 2026
- Candidates must be physically fit, possess good communication skills
- Preference will be given to their work experience at school-level training
